What team will I be joining?

You will be joining an OM team. Over 5,400 people work with Operation Mobilisation (OM) in over 110 countries to bring a message of hope to the peoples of the world. Our purpose is to motivate and equip people to share God's love with people all over the world. OM seeks to help plant and strengthen churches, especially in areas of the world where Christ is least known.

Where will I be going?

Diamonds and lace, French fries and waffles, quaint houses and gothic cathedrals... sandwiched between France, Luxembourg, Germany and The Netherlands, Belgium is a small and prosperous nation with a proud heritage. Though small, Belgium plays host to the European Union headquarters and NATO in its capital city, Brussels. Once a traditional Catholic country, 21st Century Belgium has a liberal socialist government that has introduced secular legislation including laws permitting homosexual marriage and euthanasia. The social care system is seen as one of the best in the world and recent studies show that most Belgians feel very happy about their lives.

However, statistics cannot explain the spiritual need. Belgium has lost its Christian values – its people are without hope and without God. There is a tiny evangelical church, between 0.7 and 1% of the population of 10 million, but the overwhelming majority of Belgians are completely ignorant of – and totally indifferent to – the Gospel. People don't know Jesus... and most don't want to know. Empowered by God and in partnership with other Christian organisations and churches, OM Belgium is working for change.

What will I be doing?

You will be working with children from various backgrounds through holiday programmes, puppets and games. There will also be a coffee bar in the evenings with music and different cultural events as well as the opportunity to meet the neighbourhood people on the streets.

The outreach will start off with training and an introduction to Belgium and then you will meet everyday for a time of worship and devotions

Who can join?

Individuals from the age of 18yrs. Groups and married couples (no children) are also welcome. Languages that are helpful are... Dutch, French, Arabic (classical and Moroccan), Turkish etc.

Where will I be sleeping and eating?

This will be provided for by OM Belgium.

How do I get there?

You need to arrange your own travel to and from Brussels.

Do I need a visa?

Please enquire at your local Belgian Embassy or Consulate

2 July 2009 to 17 July 2009

How much will it cost?

425 Euros per person + travel costs.

You need to apply by 25 May 2009.
