What team will I be joining?

You will be joining an OM team. Over 5,400 people work with Operation Mobilisation (OM) in over 110 countries to bring a message of hope to the peoples of the world. Our purpose is to motivate and equip people to share God's love with people all over the world. OM seeks to help plant and strengthen churches, especially in areas of the world where Christ is least known.

Where will I be going?

You will be going to Bulgaria to work with missionaries and the national church, to demonstrate and share the Gospel in the heart of the community. Bulgaria is a nation with much beauty, but many difficulties from its' communist history. It has become increasingly secular with a growing lack of awareness of and desire for God.

What will I be doing?

You will join an international team of up to 15 people working alongside missionaries based in Veliko Turnovo, Plovdiv or Burgus area. We plan to partner with those that are running kids clubs on a weekly basis. Some of these are based in homes of believers, while others are based in orphanages or schools. There will be opportunities for you to share your faith through drama, singing and testimony etc, bringing the Gospel to a broad spectrum of children in Bulgaria. There will also be opportunity to be involved in church meetings. You will be able to put into practice what you have learnt from Mission-net 2009 demonstrating God's love through words and actions. Come prepared to make a difference and be challenged.

Who can join?

Anyone from the age of 16 who is a committed Christian and is able to maintain simple conversations in English. No previous experience is needed, as orientation will be provided. We are able to take individuals or groups. We can take married couples and families, but you may be accommodated in separate rooms or homes depending on what is available.

Where will I be sleeping and eating?

You will either be sleeping with families from the church, or in church hostel type accommodation, so come prepared. We will inform you closer to the time of your exact accommodation and things to bring. Food will be provided and we need to be informed in advance of special dietary needs (vegetarian, etc..) It may be that we are unable to provide certain dietary needs depending on how specific they are, but we will try our best and you will be informed before hand as to the possibility.

How do I get there?

We will arrange one-way group travel on Monday 13 April from the mission-net congress in Germany to your team in Bulgaria. For bookings made by the end of January 2009, we anticipate it costing around 200 Euros for this one-way travel, which will include airport transfers, a low-cost airline flight and all taxes and charges.

We can arrange return travel on Sunday 19 April, if you wish to return to the same airport in Germany. For bookings made by the end of January 2009, we anticipate it costing around 400 Euros in total if you wish to take the return option. Alternatively, if you prefer to fly back straight to your own country, we can give you information about cheap travel options available. There are low-cost airlines that operate to most countries in Europe.

Do I need a visa?

Nationals from the EU, Canada, USA, Australia and NZ do not require a visa. We can provide information about visa requirements and you can also check out the website: www.mybulgaria.info/information-about-bulgaria-64.html.

What are the exact dates?

Monday 13 April to Sunday 19 April 2009

It will start immediately after the mission-net 2009 congress and you will travel from the congress to your team on Monday 13 April. Departure from Bulgaria is on Sunday 19 April in the morning, unless due to connecting flights to your homeland not coordinating, then we will have you leave the Saturday afternoon. These can be co-ordinated closer to the time.

How much will it cost?

225 Euros per person + travel costs

When do I need to apply?

By Monday 9 March 2009 at the very latest. It is advisable to apply earlier as spaces are limited. Travel costs will also be cheaper if you book before the end of January 2009.

How do I apply?
