What team will I be joining?

You will be joining an OM team. Over 5,400 people work with Operation Mobilisation (OM) in over 110 countries to bring a message of hope to the peoples of the world. Our purpose is to motivate and equip people to share God's love with people all over the world. OM seeks to help plant and strengthen churches, especially in areas of the world where Christ is least known.

Where will I be going?

You will be going to Birmingham in England to work with OM Lifehope. Once a missionary sending country, England has now become a post-Christian, secularised nation. In response to the needs and challenges facing us in our multi-cultural society our teams are working in partnership with churches to demonstrate and share the Gospel right in the heart of the community. Our mission is:

- Bringing life and hope to communities in the UK
- Partnering with the Church in its mission
- Reaching and discipling people from many nations

What will I be doing?

You will join an international team of up to 30 people working alongside a mission-minded church and reaching out to its community. OM Lifehope staff will plan the programme in consultation with the church. As the schools in the area will still be on their Easter holiday break, there will be some activities aimed at children and youth. There will also be opportunities to serve the community and take part in church-based evangelistic events. You might be involved in a kids club, youth event, drama, open airs, door-to-door, social action or other evangelistic events. You will have the opportunity to demonstrate God's love through words and actions. Come prepared to make a difference and be challenged!

Who can join?

Anyone from the age of 16 who is a committed Christian and is able to maintain simple conversations in English. No previous experience is needed, as orientation will be provided. We are able to take individuals or groups. We can also take married couples.

Where will I be sleeping and eating?

You will probably be sleeping in the church hall, so come prepared to rough it and bring a sleeping bag and mat. Food will be provided and we need to be informed in advance of special dietary needs (vegetarian, etc..)

How do I get there?

We will arrange one-way group travel on Monday 13 April from the mission-net congress in Germany to your team in England. For bookings made by the end of January 2009, we anticipate it costing around 100 Euros for this one-way travel, which will include airport transfers, a low-cost airline flight and all taxes and charges.

We can arrange return travel on Sunday 19 April, if you wish to return to the same airport in Germany. For bookings made by the end of January 2009, we anticipate it costing around 200 Euros in total if you wish to take the return option. Alternatively, if you prefer to fly back straight to your own country, we can give you information about cheap travel options available. There are low-cost airlines that operate to most countries in Europe.

Do I need a visa?

Nationals from the EU and EEA do not require a visa. For all other nationalities, we will provide an invitation letter. We can provide information about the visa procedure.

What are the exact dates?

Monday 13 April to Sunday 19 April 2009

It will start immediately after the mission-net 2009 congress and you will travel from the congress to your team on Monday 13 April. Departure is on Sunday 19 April in the afternoon or evening. We can arrange an additional night's accommodation, if it is more convenient for you to leave on Monday 20 April.

How much will it cost?

165 Euros per person + travel costs

When do I need to apply?

By Monday 9 March 2009 at the very latest. It is advisable to apply earlier as spaces are limited. Travel costs will also be cheaper if you book before the end of January 2009.

How do I apply?
