What team will I be joining?

You will be joining an OM team. Over 5,400 people work with Operation Mobilisation (OM) in over 110 countries to bring a message of hope to the peoples of the world. Our purpose is to motivate and equip people to share God's love with people all over the world. OM seeks to help plant and strengthen churches, especially in areas of the world where Christ is least known.

Where will I be going?

You will be going to work with OM Montenegro. An independent country since 2006, Montenegro is home to one of OM's newest team. After many years of visits from the OM Ships and Global Challenge teams, a regular OM team has now been established. After doing some initial language learning, their ministry will include establishing relationships with the community through opportunities like youth ministry, offering language courses and sports ministry. Once part of former Yugoslavia, Montenegro has now separated from Serbia and is working towards becoming more economically and politically stable. It is a nation that has clung to its religious roots with two thirds of its nearly 700,000 population claiming ties to the Eastern Orthodox Religion. The Evangelical Church consists of less than 150 believers. Podgorica, the capital city, has two churches and there are other church plant efforts, one in the North and the other one in the South.

What will I be doing?

OM Montenegro is a young team who are getting established in the city of Bar. Therefore, the team's ministry will not only be to share the Gospel, but also to help the OM team make more contacts in the local community. You will be involved in different types of ministries focusing on connecting with children and teenagers in the local community.

Before going on outreach, there will be a short orientation period which will help prepare the team for cultural adaptation, ministry to different religious groups (Muslim, Orthodox, etc.), different types of evangelism (children's evangelism, creative evangelism, etc.), and for working together as a team.

Who can join?

Anyone from the age of 18-65 who is ready to try new things, work with an international group and be excited about sharing the gospel with others. No previous experience is needed, as orientation will be provided. We are able to take individuals, groups and married couples.

Where will I be sleeping and eating?

You will be hosted by local families, churches, or stay in hostels. Bedding will be supplied. Food will be provided and we need to be informed in advance of special dietary needs (vegetarian, etc..)

How do I get there?

You will need to make your own flight arrangements into Podgorica airport, Montenegro, where you will be picked up on arrival and taken to the orientation site. You will also be returned to the airport by OM staff at the end of the outreach.

Do I need a visa?

Nationals from the EU, Canada, and the USA do not require a visa. We can provide more information about visa requirements for nationals from other countries and you can check requirements at:
