What team will I be joining?

You will be joining an OM team. Over 5,400 people work with Operation Mobilisation (OM) in over 110 countries to bring a message of hope to the peoples of the world. Our purpose is to motivate and equip people to share God's love with people all over the world. OM seeks to help plant and strengthen churches, especially in areas of the world where Christ is least known.

Where will I be going?

You will be going to work with OM Montenegro. An independent country since 2006, Montenegro is home to one of OM's newest team. After many years of visits from the OM Ships and Global Challenge teams, a regular OM team has now been established. After doing some initial language learning, their ministry include establishing relationships with the community through opportunities like youth ministry, offering language courses and sports ministry. Once part of former Yugoslavia, Montenegro has now separated from Serbia and is working towards becoming more economically and politically stable. It is a nation that has clung to its religious roots with two thirds of its nearly 700,000 population claiming ties to the Eastern Orthodox Religion. The Evangelical Church consist of less than 150 believers. Podgorica, the capital city, has two churches and there are other church plant efforts, one in the North and the other one in the South.

What will I be doing?

You will join an international team of up to 20 people working alongside church planting efforts and reaching out to their local communities. The team will be travelling to different locations within Montenegro where churches are being planted. The team will have the opportunity to help reach out to the each community through school visits, youth activities and other evangelistic events. You will have the opportunity to demonstrate God's love through words and actions. Come prepared to make a difference and be challenged!

Who can join?

Anyone from the age of 16 who is a committed Christian and is able to maintain simple conversations in English. No previous experience is needed, as orientation will be provided. We are able to take individuals or groups. We can also take married couples.

Where will I be sleeping and eating?

You will be hosted by local families, churches, or stay in hostels. Bedding will be supplied. Food will be provided and we need to be informed in advance of special dietary needs (vegetarian, etc..)

How do I get there?

We will arrange one-way group travel on Monday 13 April from the mission-net congress in Germany to Montenegro. For bookings made by the end of January 2009, we anticipate it costing around 200 Euros for this one-way travel, which will include airport transfers, a low-cost airline flight and all taxes and charges.

Do I need a visa?

Nationals from the EU, Canada, and the USA do not require a visa. We can provide more information about visa requirements and you can check out the website:

What are the exact dates?

Monday 13 April to Sunday 19 April 2009

It will start immediately after the mission-net 2009 congress and you will travel from the congress to your team on Monday 13 April.

How much will it cost?

125 Euros per person + travel costs

When do I need to apply?

By Monday 9 March 2009 at the very latest. It is advisable to apply earlier as spaces are limited. Travel costs will also be cheaper if you book before the end of January 2009.
